# **Medical Assisting Program Admission Requirements**

This program uses a competitive admissions process. Meeting the minimum requirements for admission will not guarantee acceptance to the Medical Assisting diploma program. The deadline to apply to the Fall 2018 Medical Assisting program is Friday, May 11, 2018

- **1.** Applicants must be at least 17 years of age to apply to the Medical Assisting Program and 16 to apply for acceptance to the college.
- 1. Apply online at https://www.savannahtech.edu/admissions/apply-online/
  The application fee for a new student is \$25.00 and \$10.00 for a readmit student.
- **2.** Arrange to take the *Placement test* by appointment with the testing office. Contact admissions.
- 3. Complete and/or forward the following to admission's office
  - a. An official high school transcript or GED certificate
  - b. Official College transcripts (if any)
- **4.** Complete a financial aid application. PELL grants and other aid are available to qualified people if and only when they complete the financial aid application.
- 5. Obtain regular admission status to Savannah Technical College.

**7.** Students must complete the Health Care Assistant Technical Certificate of Credit (TCC)\*\* with one of the following specializations to be considered for admission into the Medical Assisting diploma program: Medical Coding/Insurance Data Entry Specialist, Medical Front Office, Phlebotomy, Nurse Aide, Patient Care Technician, Central Sterile Processing or Dental Assisting. Students who have completed the EMT Basic certificate are also eligible to apply.

**8.** A minimum GPA of 2.5 is required for entry into the Medical Assisting program. The six (6) courses used to calculate the Grade Point Average (GPA) are:

ENGL 1010 OR ENGL 1101

MATH 1012 OR MATH 1103 or higher

ALHS 1090

ALHS 1011 OR BIOL 2113, BIOL 2113L and BIOL 2114, BIOL 2114L

PSYC 1010 OR PSYC 1101

COMP 1000

When a course is taken more than once, the highest grade earned will be used to calculate the GPA. Transfer credits will be included in the GPA calculation where applicable.

- **9.** ALHS classes that are transferred into Savannah Technical College are subject to a 5 (five) year expiration date per the college catalog.
- **10.** Applications are accepted online on the Medical Assisting webpage from April 1<sup>st</sup> through May 11<sup>th</sup> for Fall Semester start of the Medical Assisting diploma program. Student must have completed/transferred the following 6 (six) required courses:

ENGL 1010, MATH 1012, PSYC 1010, COMP 1000, ALHS 1011 and ALHS 1090 (or equivalents as noted above) by the end of Spring Semester 2018. The TCC must be completed prior to the start of the Fall 2018 MA program.

Application closes on Friday, May 11, 2018 at 10:00 am.

- **11.** Cohort class selection is based upon the highest GPA. The students with the highest grade point average will be accepted into the program.
- \*\*Students who have completed the **Health Care Science Technical Certificate of Credit (TCC)** with a specialization in Surgical Technology or Dental Hygiene are required to complete the 6 courses or the equivalents needed to apply to the Medical Assisting program.

#### Note:

Students may be required to successfully pass a criminal background check and drug screen analysis before placement in clinical settings.
